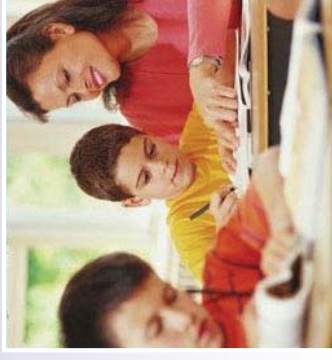

Conscious Discipline leads teachers and staff through a process that promotes permanent behavior changes in teachers/staff and children. The change is from a traditional compliance model of discipline to a relationship-based community model. The traditional model of discipline is founded on rules which are upheld through the use of consequences. The Conscious Discipline model offers a relationship based community model of classroom management where the “School Family” is the core.

The school family is held together through communication skills which are taught during conflict moments in the classroom and active learning lessons. The goal of the school family is to create problem solvers and is built on three major premises:

- Controlling and changing ourselves is possible and has profound impact on others
- Connectedness governs behavior
- Conflict is an opportunity to teach
